HPU proudly celebrated the accomplishments of its fall 2024 graduates on Tuesday, December 17, with two commencement ceremonies held at the Hawai'i Convention Center. Nearly 400 students were awarded degrees, marking the culmination of their academic journeys.

The morning ceremony honored doctoral, master's, and graduate

certificate recipients, while the afternoon celebrated associate, bachelor's, and undergraduate certificate graduates. HPU President John Gotanda, J.D., presided over both ceremonies, offering words of encouragement and presenting degrees alongside Acting Provost Brenda Jensen, Ph.D., who served as Master of Ceremonies.

A highlight of this fall's commencement was the graduation of HPU's inaugural cohort of 93 Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) students. These graduates represent Hawai'i's first-ever DPT professionals, completing the state's only accredited program. Launched in 2022, the program aims to address local and national needs for skilled physical therapists.
