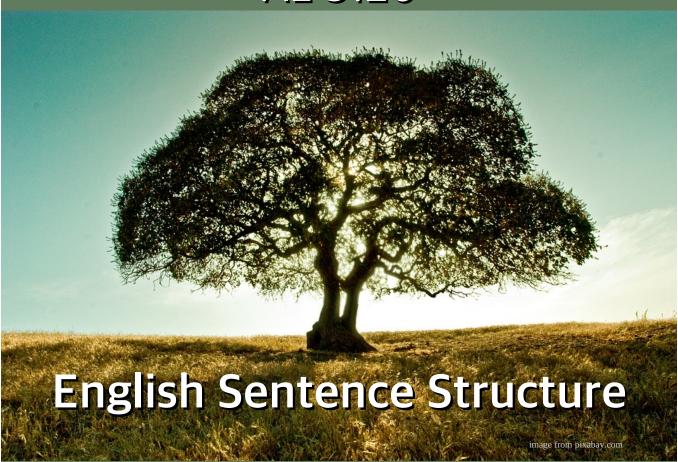
AL 3120



In this course, you will learn about

- how English words function to build sentences
- how phrases are formed
- what grammar rules govern different English sentence types
- how to identify English grammar errors by speakers of other
 languages and what teaching techniques can be used to address them

COURSE DESCRIPTION: An introduction to English grammar for the prospective ESOL instructor. Concepts investigated include parts of speech, grammatical relations, phrases, sentence types, and sentence structure. The focus is on the analysis of problems ESOL students might have acquiring English syntax.
