

Translation in Second Language Acquisition



In this course, you will explore answers to key questions such as:

- What does it take to translate concepts between languages?
- What can we learn about cross-linguistic and cross-cultural interpretations?
- How can translation be used to promote second language learning?

Course description: An investigation of translation problems due to differences in structure, concept, culture, and style among languages. Other topics include equivalence, untranslatability, languages in contact, and the use of translation as a tool for teaching and learning a second language.
