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## In this course, you will learn

- appropriate methods and techniques for presenting, practicing, and reviewing materials to specific groups of ESOL learners
- strategies for addressing individual differences that affect learning and teaching
- sound teaching practices appropriate for various teaching situations
- second language acquisition principles underlying speaking and listening

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** An investigation of current materials and methods for teaching oral fluency, pronunciation, listening skills, and oral grammar. Also included are methods and materials for evaluating speaking and listening. Students observe oral fluency/listening classes, as well as prepare and present short teaching demonstrations.
