- appropriate methods and techniques for presenting, practicing, and reviewing materials to specific groups of ESOL learners
- strategies for addressing individual differences that affect learning and teaching
- sound teaching principles appropriate for various teaching situations
- second language acquisition processes underlying reading and writing skills

COURSE DESCRIPTION: An investigation of current materials and methods for teaching and reading and writing skills, Also included are methods and materials for building vocabulary, addressing errors, and evaluating reading and writing. Students prepare lesson plans and present short teaching demonstrations.
