



HPU Economics for Hawai'i Teachers Course - Earn PD Credit

Economics course available for professional development (PD) credit for teachers of all subjects grades K-12. No previous knowledge of economics is required.

THE COURSE

Hawai'i Pacific University's 'Economics for Hawai'i Teachers' course will strengthen your economic understanding and impart effective pedagogy to integrate economic principles into your lessons. The course provides teaching materials including videos, lessons plans, podcasts, and on-going teacher support, and is aligned with the Hawai'i Core Standards in Social Studies (HCSSS).

This course is produced by the Hawai'i Pacific University Center for Entrepreneurship and Economic Education (CEEE) in collaboration with the Hawai'i Council on Economic Education (HCEE). Completion of the course provides three graduate level university credits. The course runs eight weeks on Tuesdays from October 25th – Dec 12th, 5:15-8:10pm at Aloha Tower Marketplace.

TUITION AND SCHOLARSHIP:

A full scholarship will be provided. This course is free to all grade K-12 Hawai'i public and private school teachers. To register a \$200 application fee will initially be charged, but is refunded upon satisfactory participation.

HOW TO APPLY:

To register, follow these easy steps:

1. Click **this link** to start your application and create your username and password.
2. After you receive your username and password by email, navigate to **this link**.
3. In the right-hand column titled 'GRADUATE', select 'MASTERS PROGRAMS'.
4. On the top right of the next page click 'Log-in'.
5. Enter your username and password.
6. Click 'START A NEW APPLICATION'.
7. Under the heading 'START A NEW GRADUATE APPLICATION', Click 'START APPLICATION'.
8. Indicate that you are applying 'without the intention of pursuing a degree at HPU' and that your program is 'Undeclared - non-degree seeking', and choose term 'Fall 2022'.
9. Fill in the application and when you reach the section 'Course Selection'; for 'Course 1' enter 'ED6463', for 'CRN 1' enter '5650', and for 'Credit 1' enter '3'.
10. In the final section titled 'Additional Information', when asked if you have a fee waiver code click 'Yes' and enter 'ED6463'.
11. Fill in the rest of your application and submit online.
12. The final step to register for the class is to pay the enrollment deposit of \$200.
