

Parent Refusal to Provide Information for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

According to the Federal Guidelines, students whose parents refuse to submit information to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) **may be eligible to receive loan assistance through the Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan program.**

To accomplish this, our office requires a signed statement by the parent(s) to include the following specific information:

- That the parents refuse to provide information for the FAFSA.
- That the parents do not and will not provide any financial support to the student.
- Date the parental support of student ended.

If the parents refuse to sign and date a statement to this effect, you must get documentation from a third party such as a teacher, minister, counselor, or court. If there are unusual circumstances which prevent you from asking your parent to sign this form, please schedule an appointment with a Financial Aid Specialist for guidance on your specific circumstance.
