UNDERGRADUATE VALEDICTORY SPEAKER

Sophia Paris Siangco

Bachelor of Arts in Political Science

Sophia Siangco, from Honolulu and a graduate of Kamehameha Schools Kapālama Campus, completed HPU’s dual-credit program in 2023, earning both her high school diploma and an associate degree. Continuing her accelerated path, she chose HPU to finish her bachelor’s degree, achieving Dean’s List honors from 2023 to 2025 and winning the 2025 HPU-sponsored The Leaders and the Led prize for her essay, “The Intersection of Conservation and Reciprocal Connection: Mauna Kea as a Site of Memory.”

Siangco served as a social science research assistant in an HPU political science faculty lab, contributing to the Healthy Hawaiian Project and studies on Native Hawaiian and Pacific Islander identity. Her work deepened her understanding of indigenous data sovereignty and researcher-community relationships. She also holds CITI, Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative, Program certifications in social and behavioral research and responsible conduct of research.

Beyond academics, Siangco was active in the HPU Debate Team, earning first place at the Edith Kanaka‘ole Hawai‘i Island Debate competition. She performed with the HPU Theatre in student- and department-led productions and played violin with the HPU Orchestra, playing a repertoire that ranged from classical works to contemporary movie scores and bluegrass tunes. She also studied piano and organ with two HPU faculty, broadening her musical abilities and strengthening her passion for creating music.

After graduation, Siangco plans to prepare for law school admission, focusing on programs with robust indigenous law curricula. She hopes to return to Hawai‘i to practice law.

GRADUATE VALEDICTORY SPEAKER

Shanicqua Lavon Carter

Master of Business Administration

Shanicqua Carter, originally from Camden, New Jersey, has lived across the U.S., including South Carolina, North Carolina, Georgia, and Kansas, and currently calls Hawai‘i home. Her career spans over a decade of experience in customer service, digital strategy, military logistics, project management, and accounting. She is the accounting manager for Hawai‘i Meals on Wheels, where she oversees financial operations, reporting, compliance, and process improvement in support of the organization’s mission of serving Hawai‘i’s kūpuna (elders). She also served five years in the U.S. Army.

Carter’s academic journey reflects a strong commitment to integrating business leadership with data-driven solutions. A member of Delta Mu Delta international honor society, she completed multiple professional certifications including program management, project management, and agile development and scrum, skills that complement her goal of advancing in technology, finance, and administrative leadership roles.

For her MBA Capstone Project, Carter and her team developed a comprehensive business plan for a Hawai‘i-based meal-prep company. Completing this project allowed her to apply the full range of knowledge gained throughout the MBA program in leadership, finance, analytics, and strategic planning in a real-world scenario. The project reinforced the importance of data-driven insights, strong teamwork, and strategic alignment across business functions.

As Carter graduates with her MBA, she reflects that HPU and the program strengthened her confidence, sharpened her leadership abilities, and prepared her for the next steps in her career, including completing the Master of Science in Data Science at HPU, which she anticipates finishing in fall 2026.

UNDERGRADUATE VALEDICTORY SPEAKER

Jejomar Obidos Balanay

Bachelor of Science in Nursing

Jejomar Balanay of Ewa Beach, Hawai'i, chose HPU after seeing the transformation his brother experienced as a student. Inspired by his mother's compassion as a healthcare provider, he committed to a nursing career focused on delivering quality, patient-centered care.

His clinical training spans post-anesthesia care at Pali Momi Medical Center, neurological care at Straub Benioff Medical Center, labor and delivery at Kapiolani Medical Center for Women and Children, behavioral health at Hawai'i State Hospital, and long-term care at Ka Punawai Ola.

Beyond academics, Balanay joined a medical mission to Moloka'i, where he delivered care, gathering vitals, serving as a scribe, and mentoring junior student nurses. During a cultural exchange with Tokyo Women's Medical University, he visited hospitals and care units, observing Japan's community-based care. He also helped present "The Effects of Digital Media on Brain Development in Children's Executive Function," an evidence-based study examining the scope of the issue and offering recommendations to help adolescents maintain executive functioning, which refers to the essential skills used daily to plan, solve problems, and manage emotions.

Active in campus life, Balanay served as secretary and Level 3 representative of the Student Nurses Association and is a member of Alpha Chi and Alpha Lambda Delta honor societies. He has volunteered as a medic at major community events, including the Honolulu Marathon.

Looking ahead, Balanay aspires to work in an intensive care unit, critical care unit, or perioperative area, combining clinical expertise with a passion for guiding patients through recovery.

GRADUATE VALEDICTORY SPEAKER

Joshua Fontaine

Doctor of Occupational Therapy

Joshua Fontaine, originally from London, Canada, began his health sciences journey earning a Diploma in Fitness and Health Promotion and an Honors Bachelor of Applied Science in Kinesiology. After moving to Honolulu three years ago, he learned of HPU's newly launched Doctor of Occupational Therapy (OTD) program and became a member of its inaugural cohort. Active in the Aloha Committee, he welcomed guest speakers, supported outreach events, and shared his journey through admissions activities for prospective students. Fontaine received the Aloha Award for embodying the spirit of aloha and leadership to serve the greater good. He is a member of the American Occupational Therapy Association.

His fieldwork included acute care at Straub Benioff Medical Center, managing complex neuro, cardiac, and burn cases, and early intervention at Leeward Early Childhood Services Program, supporting infants and toddlers through sensory-based strategies and family coaching.

For his Capstone Project at Kapiolani Medical Center for Women and Children, Fontaine developed a holistic intervention resource guide for individuals with high-risk pregnancies. Using the biopsychosocial model as the framework, he addressed physical, emotional, and social challenges while providing postpartum resources. Fontaine collaborated closely with therapists to ensure the guide prioritized patient value and allowed for practical, seamless implementation with therapists.

Excited to continue growing in the field, Fontaine plans to begin his career in adult rehabilitation, a setting he found deeply fulfilling, where he witnessed the transformative impact of OT services.

ACADEMIC HONORS AND DEGREE CONFERRAL

Academic honors and degrees for this ceremony are calculated based upon grades earned prior to graduation. Final honors and degrees are conferred when the University Registrar posts the degree to the student's official transcript. Students graduating with HPU honors are wearing honors regalia as follows: Bachelor degree students graduating ♦ (3.9 – 4.0 HPA) receive a medallion with a blue ribbon; ♦ (3.7 – 3.89 HPA) receive a medallion with a blue and white ribbon.

Honors Regalia

Graduating students wearing honors regalia are members of local, national, or international honor societies. Honor cords, pins, or medallions identify students as members of one of the societies or programs listed below:

ALPHA CHI: Blue and green cords.

Membership is limited to the top 10% of juniors and seniors based on their HPU GPA and completion of 30 credits at HPU.

ALPHA EPSILON DELTA: Red and violet cords. Membership is limited to students with at least a 3.2 GPA in science courses and a major interest in medicine.

ALPHA LAMBDA DELTA: Red, gold, and white cords. Membership is limited to students in their first year at HPU who have achieved a GPA of 3.5.

ALPHA SIGMA LAMBDA: Maroon and gold cords. Membership is limited to undergraduate students at least 27 years of age who have a GPA of 3.2.

BETA BETA BETA: Green and red cords. Membership is limited to students enrolled in biological sciences with a GPA of at least 3.0.

CHI ALPHA SIGMA: Gold medallions. Membership is limited to students in HPU athletics who have earned the equivalent of an intercollegiate varsity letter and have maintained a GPA of at least 3.4.

DELTA MU DELTA: Purple and gold cords. Membership is limited to undergraduate and graduate students in the business degree program having a minimum GPA of 3.4 and 3.6 respectively.

DELTA PHI TAU: Teal and gold cords in a single cord. Membership is limited to Doctor of Physical Therapist students who demonstrate excellence, integrity, and professionalism in the areas of academic achievement (top 25%), leadership, service or research, and demonstrate strong moral character, ethics and the core values of the PT profession.

KAPPA MU EPSILON: Lapel pins.

Membership is limited to undergraduate students majoring in mathematics who have earned a GPA of 3.0 or better and rank in the upper 35% of their class.

LAMBDA PI ETA: Red and white cords and lapel pin. Membership is limited to students majoring in communication who have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 for all communication courses.

MU KAPPA TAU: Royal blue cord and lapel pin. Membership is limited to undergraduate or graduate marketing students who have a cumulative GPA of 3.25 and undergraduate students who are either in the top 10% of their junior class or top 20% of their senior class.

PHI ALPHA: Single gold cord. Membership is limited to students enrolled in the social work degree program who have an overall cumulative GPA of 3.0 and a GPA of 3.25 in social work courses.

PHI ALPHA THETA: Lapel pins and sashes. Membership is limited to students majoring in history ranking in the top 35% of their class with a GPA of at least 3.1 in history classes.

PI ALPHA ALPHA: Lapel pin and blue and gold cords. Membership is limited to students in disciplines related to public service, such as public administration and criminal justice, with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 for undergraduates and 3.7 for graduate students.

PI SIGMA ALPHA: Medallion. Membership is limited to students majoring in or having taken at least six upper-division credits in political science, with a cumulative GPA of 3.2.

PSI CHI: Blue and silver cords.

Membership is limited to students in psychology who have a cumulative GPA of 3.45 and rank in the top 35% of their class.

SIGMA DELTA PI: Lapel pins. Membership is limited to students studying Spanish language and culture who have a GPA of 3.0 in their Spanish courses and rank in the top 35% of their class.

SIGMA TAU DELTA: Red and black cords. Membership is limited to students majoring in English or minoring in writing, film studies, or literature who have a cumulative GPA of 3.44.

SIGMA THETA TAU: Orchid and white cords. Membership is limited to nursing students who have a GPA of 3.0 (3.5 for graduate students) and are of junior or senior status with a ranking in the highest 35% of the nursing class.

UPSILON PI EPSILON: Maroon and white cords and lapel pin. Membership is limited to students in the study of information systems, computer science, and computer information systems who have a GPA of 3.0 for undergraduate students or a 3.5 for graduate students.

RESIDENTIAL HONORS PROGRAM:

Black and gold-lettering sashes signify a Residential Honors Program student who has maintained a cumulative GPA of at least 3.4, completed six honors-designated courses, participated in extracurricular activities, and completed an interdisciplinary Senior Honors Project.

ACADEMIC REGALIA AND DEGREE CONFERRAL

Academic Regalia

Graduates and faculty participating in HPU's graduation ceremonies wear traditional academic attire. Associate and bachelor's degree candidates wear royal blue gowns with straight sleeves. Master's degree candidates wear royal blue gowns with oblong sleeves and hoods with colors that represent their degree programs, accented with silver and grey. Doctoral candidates wear royal blue gowns with bell-shaped sleeves, featuring three velvet bars and blue velvet panels down the front with the university logo, a blue velvet tam, and hoods in the colors that represent their degree program, accented with silver and grey. Faculty may wear the regalia representing the university from which they received their terminal degree. At HPU, graduates may also wear lei in addition to honors regalia. Tassel colors represent the various degree programs.
