

## HPU BSN - Competitive Application Pathway

<b>Pathway Option For</b>	<p>Currently enrolled HPU students taking BSN pre-requisites and general education, not yet in upper division BSN Level 1 courses AND all entering Transfer Students.</p> <p>Admission is competitive and based upon remaining seats available after HPU student guaranteed pathway progression requests have been completed. Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee admission into upper division BSN Level 1 Nursing.</p>
<b>Overall Minimum Cumulative GPA</b>	Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA (all earned college credit) or higher at time of application
<b>BSN Minimum Prerequisite GPA</b>	Minimum 3.0 or higher GPA in BSN prerequisite courses, with all grades C or higher at time of application, and no more than two prerequisite courses in progress. (A&P + L together count as 1 course)
<b>Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)</b>	<p>Preferred Requirement: Completion of Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Entrance Test with minimum overall total score of 70%.</p> <p>- Note: TEAS requirement may be waived on a case-by-case basis with outstanding science course grades.</p>
<b>Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Valid Scores Info</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- TEAS must be within 2 years of progression request deadline</li> <li>- 3 maximum TEAS attempts within the 2-year period</li> <li>- Minimum 14 day waiting period in-between tests is required</li> <li>- Highest valid TEAS score report will be accepted</li> </ul>
<b>Letters of Rec</b>	Two Professional Letters of Recommendation
<b>Personal Statement</b>	Personal Statement
<b>General Education</b>	Priority consideration given to applicants who have <u>all</u> General Education courses either completed, or in progress at the time of application. No more than 2 GE courses remaining by start of BSN upper division Level 1 courses.
<b>Pre-Requisites</b>	<p>BIOL 2030 - Anatomy and Physiology I</p> <p>BIOL 2031 - Anatomy and Physiology I Laboratory</p> <p>BIOL 2032 - Anatomy and Physiology II</p> <p>BIOL 2033 - Anatomy and Physiology II Laboratory</p> <p>BIOL 2040 – Microbiology</p> <p>BIOL 2041 – Microbiology Laboratory (*effective Fall 2023)</p> <p>CHEM 1000 - Introduction to Chemistry</p> <p>MATH 1123 – Statistics</p> <p>WRI 1200 - Research, Argument &amp; Writing Priority consideration given to applicants who have all pre-requisite courses completed at the time of the application.</p>
<b>Repeated Courses</b>	<p>BSN pre-requisite courses taken at HPU in which one earns a grade below C may be eligible for “grade forgiveness” as defined by the HPU Course Repeat Policy. In addition, for pre-requisite courses taken at HPU one repeat allowed per pre-requisite course, and 12 maximum credits.</p> <p>For repeated courses taken outside of HPU, all pre-requisite course attempts will be included in the calculated pre-requisite GPA.</p>
<b>Other</b>	<p>No prior nursing program dismissal.</p> <p>All official transcripts for course work taken outside of HPU must be received before the start of the term</p>
<b>Fall Deadline</b>	15-Feb (Priority) and 1- April (Secondary space permitting)
<b>Fall Decision Notification</b>	5-Mar (Priority) and 1- May (Secondary space permitting)
<b>Spring Deadline</b>	15-Oct (Priority), 15-Nov (Secondary space permitting) 15-Dec (space permitting)
<b>Spring Decision Notification</b>	15-Nov (Priority) and Rolling notification for Secondary deadline
<b>LPN-BSN, HM-BSN, RN-BSN</b>	Fall Entry Term Only (Submit documents by the Fall Deadline)
