

HPU BSN - Competitive Application Pathway	
Pathway Option For	Currently enrolled HPU students taking BSN pre-requisites and general education, not yet in upper division BSN Clinical Level courses AND all entering Transfer Students. Admission is competitive and based upon remaining seats available after HPU student guaranteed pathway progression requests have been completed. Meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee admission into upper division BSN Clinical Level 1 Nursing.
Overall Minimum Cumulative GPA	Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA (all earned college credit) or higher at time of application
BSN Minimum Pre-requisite GPA	Minimum 3.0 or higher GPA in BSN prerequisite courses, with all grades C or higher at time of application, and no more than two prerequisite courses in progress. (A&P + lab together count as 1 course)
Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS)	Requirement: Completion of Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Entrance Test with minimum overall total score of 70%.
Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) Valid Scores Info	- TEAS must be within 2 years of progression request/BSN application deadline - 3 maximum TEAS attempts within the 2-year period - Minimum 14 day waiting period in-between tests is required - Highest valid TEAS score report will be accepted
Letters of Rec	Two Professional Letters of Recommendation
Personal Statement	Personal Statement – 500 word limit
General Education	Priority consideration given to applicants who have all lower division General Education courses and Major electives either completed, or in progress at the time of application. No more than 2 GE courses remaining by start of BSN clinical Level courses.
Pre-Requisites	BIOL 2030 - Anatomy and Physiology I BIOL 2031 - Anatomy and Physiology I Laboratory BIOL 2032 - Anatomy and Physiology II BIOL 2033 - Anatomy and Physiology II Laboratory BIOL 2040 – Microbiology BIOL 2041 – Microbiology Laboratory CHEM 1000 - Introduction to Chemistry MATH 1123 – Statistics Priority consideration given to applicants who have all pre-requisite courses completed at the time of the application, and whose pre-requisite courses have been taken within the past 5 years.
Repeated Courses	BSN pre-requisite courses taken at HPU in which one earns a grade below C may be eligible for “grade forgiveness” as defined by the HPU Course Repeat Policy. Only one repeat allowed per pre-requisite course, and 12 maximum credits. For repeated courses taken prior to enrolling at HPU, the highest grade will be used but all pre-requisite course attempts will be factored into the overall application score.
Other	No prior nursing program dismissal. All official transcripts for course work taken outside of HPU must be received before the start of the term
Fall Deadline	15-Feb (Priority), 1- April (Secondary space permitting)
Fall Decision Notification	15-Mar (Priority), 1- May (Secondary)
Spring Deadline	1-Oct (Priority)
Spring Decision Notification	1-Nov (Priority)
LPN-BSN, HM-BSN, RN-BSN	Fall Entry Term Only (Submit documents by the Fall Deadline)
